LEGENDARY VINEYARDS OF CARNEROS

Hyde Vineyards - A Labor of Love

Founded in 1979 by Larry Hyde, this 150 acre sustainably farmed vineyard is one of the finest “single vineyards” in California. Just due east of The Carneros Inn, the Hyde Vineyards are planted to eight varietals based on the varied soil types and exposures within the vineyard. The meticulously farmed fruit is sought after by many famous winemakers, such as Paul Hobbs, Patz & Hall and Dave Ramey. It is also the source for Larry’s, and partner Aubert de Villaine’s wine label, known as HdV - or Hyde de Villaine, which produces exquisite wines under the guise of winemaker Stephane Vivier. The fruit and resultant wines never fail to capture the flavors of Carneros - smoky, intense Pinot Noir, spicy, Rhône-like Syrah, and fruit driven Chardonnays with great minerality.

Hudson Vineyards - “The Laughing Land”

In the late 1880’s, this was the Talcoa Vineyard, known by it’s inhabitants as “The Laughing Land” – these gently rolling hills are covered with vines which were replanted and purchased by Lee Hudson in 1981. Hudson Vineyards has contracts with 32 wineries, which proudly bear the name as a single vineyard. Lee, with the assistance of John Kongsgaard, also produces Chardonnay and Syrah under the Hudson Vineyards label.

Durell Vineyards - “His and Hers”

Located in the hills overlooking the town of Sonoma, Durell Vineyard at Sand Hill Ranch extends from the Southern end of the Sonoma Valley into the western portion of the cool Carneros region. This location provides afternoon breezes that slow ripening, producing richer-flavored grapes with lots of minerality.

Ed Durell, a San Francisco food broker, had acquired the land in 1977 with the intent of turning it into a cattle ranch - but in 1979 began planting grapes instead. In 1980, after Durell hired Steve Hill to manage the ranch, the pair decided to focus exclusively on grapes, which they began selling to Sonoma County wineries in 1982.

Bill and Ellie Price bought the property from Ed Durell in 1998. The couple, who have since divorced but continue to amicably own Durell together, also got bitten by the winemaking bug. They now each have their own wines made from Durell fruit - Three Sticks (his) and Sand Hill (hers). The winemaker for both is Chateau St. Jean veteran Don Van Staaveren.
