For low-key luxury this Valentine's Day, take advantage of these local romantic packages. The "Rated M" stay at the 12-room Napa boutique hotel **Milliken Creek** includes two nights' accommodations, a 75-minute couples' aromatherapy massage and turndown treats like local Chuao Chocolates, a bottle of Seduction wine from O'Brien Estates and your own Kama Sutra kit. Each morning, gourmet breakfast options include a picnic overlooking the Napa River. At the newly renovated and renamed **Hotel Yountville** (formerly the Yountville Inn), couples can take a painting class with local artist Don Hatfield. The morning includes a picnic brunch prepared by chef Joshua Steinberg. Still aren't sure about the difference between a Kir Royale and a French 75? That night, take a complimentary mixology class at the hotel's guest-only restaurant Hopper Creek. With the "Celebrate Romance" package at **The Carneros Inn** (pictured above), a bottle of sparkling wine awaits in your private cottage—have a glass or two, or jump on one of the resort's deluxe bicycles for a cruise around the local vineyards. Enjoy dinner for two at Farm, where chef Ryan Jette incorporates fresh items from the on-property culinary garden.
