Carneros Inn to open new space

Phase Two of the Carneros Inn is getting close to completion. Its new restaurant Farm is already serving guests of the hotel, and it should open in mid-November.

The general store and post office should open in January. The store will sell sundries, take-out food and other merchandise.

The town square provide a site for community gatherings including a possible Farmers Market featuring local produce.

Farm supplements the fine Boon Fly Cafe with its classic casual American food and the hilltop restaurant, which is now be used for breakfasts and lunches for the hotel guests as well as special events and meetings.

The chef is Kimball Jones.

Farm has 100 seats, 60 on a patio and 80 in an alfresco covered cocktail lounge.

The expansion also includes 6,000 square feet of conference space in two rooms, an outdoor garden and event space, a pool, spa, kid's pool, fitness center and yoga studio.

The resort has also started building 17 new shared-ownership two-bedroom cottages that should be finished in March.
